Electric Vehicle Feasibility Study Update

The draft feasibility study was completed in October, with a workshop held in Benalla in mid-November to explore the report in more detail with NDEVR. Participants also heard from Wollemi Consulting describing their involvement with the Sunshine Coast Solar farm and opportunities for powering EVs with renewables, and Mitsubishi provided an Outlander Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV) to view and test drive.



Draft Business Case Update

The development of the business case for the project is currently underway, based on a positive feasibility study. The draft will be completed by the end of 2017.

EV Forums

Planning for the forums to be held in March 2018 has commenced. The forums will showcase the learnings from the project, and raise awareness about EVs, infrastructure and the opportunities EVs bring to our region.

The GBGA is currently preparing a response to the State Government Parliamentary Inquiry into EVs on behalf of our member councils.

This is a 12 month partnership project funded and supported by eleven regional councils, the Goulburn Broken Greenhouse Alliance, and the Victorian Government's Collaborating Council – Sustainability Fund Partnership.
